Nomination Process

- Nominations will be accepted starting Monday, October 3rd through Wednesday, October 12th.
- Nominations may be made by any CYC member of any age or relation to candidate. Candidates may nominate themselves.
- Nominations may be submitted via email to me or via letter dropped off in the main office.
- Nominees will be notified on Thursday, October 13th.
- If a person has been nominated for multiple positions, they must choose ONE position.

Application/Campaign

- Nominations must be accepted by nominees via submission of the **Candidate Information/Campaign Packet**
- Packets must be received no later than 1700 on Friday, November 4th.

Voting

- Each CYC membership will receive 1 (one) vote.
- Voting will occur at the Annual Awards dinner on Sunday, November 13th.
- There will be **no opportunity** to vote outside of the above time.

Junior Board appointees are to abide by the CYC Junior Division Constitution and Bylaws. In addition to performing the duties of your position, you are expected to support and promote Junior Program activities. It is a privilege to be installed as a Junior Board Member. While in this leadership role appropriate behavior is expected. The term of office is from December 1 thru November 30 of the following year.

JUNIOR COMMODORE

The Junior Commodore shall be the primary representative of the Junior Program. He/She shall represent the Junior Program at ceremonies and functions. He/She may make a report on behalf of the Jr. Members at the monthly Board of Directors meeting. He/She may make notice and call for Jr. Member Meetings. He/She shall promote participation by Junior Members in club activities and regattas. He/She shall volunteer at Junior Program activities and fundraisers. He/She shall introduce the Junior Board and Fleet Captains and make a report at the CYC Opening Day ceremonies held in May.

JUNIOR VICE COMMODORE

The Junior Vice Commodore shall assist the Junior Commodore with their duties and shall "stand in" at ceremonies or functions that the Junior Commodore is unable to attend. He/She shall volunteer at Junior Program activities and fundraisers. He/She shall perform assigned tasks at the CYC Opening Day Ceremony in May.

JUNIOR REAR COMMODORE

The Junior Rear Commodore shall help the Junior Commodore and Junior Vice Commodore. He/She shall "stand in" for them if either is unable to attend a ceremony or function. He/She shall volunteer at Junior Program activities and fundraisers. He/She shall perform assigned tasks and be introduced at the CYC Opening Day Ceremony in May.

JUNIOR SAIL FLEET CAPTAINS

Fleet Captains will be appointed for Sabots, Lasers, 420's and 29er's. He/She shall promote participation in regattas and events from sailors in their fleet. He/She shall volunteer for Junior Program activities and fundraisers. He/She shall perform assigned tasks and be introduced at the CYC Opening Day Ceremony in May.

JUNIOR ANGLER'S FLEET CAPTAIN

In addition to above sail fleets duties; the Junior Angler's Fleet Captain shall organize and promote at least one fishing trip during the year. Also, He/She shall promote fishing opportunities between Junior Members and Sr. Members. He/She is encouraged to promote and attend CYC Rod & Reel Club Meetings held the first Tuesday of each month.

All Junior Officers and Fleet Captains should encourage water safety and discourage pollution in Glorietta Bay, San Diego Bay and the Pacific Ocean.
